Touring Car and 12th Scale Classes are to follow AARCMCC 2015 Technical Rule Set, with the exception of Eurostock to run in 10.5 (Blinky) configuration.

Please Note: Blinky Classes will be heavily scrutinized & if any car is found to be running ESC Timing it will be DISQUALIFIED from the Event.

Note: - There is no cross-entering between touring classes & no car swapping amongst competitors.

Minimum Weight:

Touring Cars	1380 grams <u>including</u> Transponder.
12 th Scale	750 grams including Transponder.
Formula 1	1000 grams including Transponder

Tyres:

This is an Open Tyre Event; however Tyres must meet AARCMCC Technical rules as per respective classes. Formula 1 is to run on Rubber Tyres if possible please.

Traction Compounds are allowed.

Batteries:

All Batteries must be Hardcase and must be AARCMCC/ROAR approved 30days prior to this event. Lipo sacks must be used for the Safety of All Entrants and Spectators.

Racing Times;

Modified	5 Minutes
Stock and Sportsman	6 Minutes
12 th Scale	8 Minutes
Formula 1	6 Minutes

RACE TIMING;

Qualifying will be by The IFMAR point's method. Best 3 rounds of 4.

The finals will be Best 2 rounds of 3.

Please Note; MRT Transponders are **NOT** compatible with the RC4 Decoder. All competitors must have personal transponders.

Marshaling Duties;

Drivers will be required to marshal the race immediately following their race. If you are unable to marshal you must provide a substitute marshal and inform race control prior to the start of the race concerned.

Failure to marshal will mean the loss of best result in heat or final.

Scrutineering;

All cars are to be placed on the scrutineering bench in front of canteen after each heat and final for random checks, cars may be collected after the completion of your marshalling duties or if scrutineer is satisfied.

Trophies;

Trophies will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions in A Finals of each class and one Concourse trophy will also be awarded.

Canteen;

Canteen facilities available at the Track for Breakfast & Lunch.
